The Union Township Board of Supervisors public hearing to consider amending the Township Code, specifically Chapter 280-7: Zoning definitions to provide a definition for pharmacy and to include Medical Marijuana Dispensaries under the pharmacy category as defined by the Pennsylvania Medical Marijuana Act was called to order by Chairperson, Heather Daerr. The pledge of allegiance was recited.

Also, in attendance Gary Sweat-Solicitor, Michael Cruny-Attorney, Nicole Dooley-Secretary/Treasurer, James Hershman-Engineer and Jarrod D'Amico-Zoning/Code Enforcement Officer.

Solicitor, Gary Sweat turned the Public Hearing over to his associate Michael Cruny. Mr. Sweat stated Mr. Cruny drafted the amendment and supervised the review of the amended ordinance with the Union Township Planning Department.

Attorney, Michael Cruny stated the Township Zoning Ordinance already provides for pharmacy and they are a permitted use in the commercial districts of the Township Code. The amendment of the ordinance is to provide a pharmacy definition. Mr. Cruny also noted it adds the definition of a Medical Marijuana Dispensary that is defined by the Pennsylvania Medical Marijuana Act.

Solicitor, Gary Sweat question Mr. Cruny if the Union Township Planning Department recommended the amendment of the ordinance to the Board of Supervisor? Mr. Cruny advised Solicitor Sweat of the Planning Departments recommendation.
