WHAT NEEDS A PERMIT

Residential Zoning Permits:

All types of construction should begin with a zoning permit application. Certain types of construction DO NOT require a building permit, but DO require a submittal of a zoning permit application (ie. a zoning permit is required for fences, sheds under 200 sq. ft, carports, etc., so that the property can be reviewed for the appropriate setbacks, but a building permit will not be required)

Residential Building Permits:

In addition to a zoning permit, a building permit is required for: New single-family dwellings, duplexes, or townhouse buildings, home additions, attached or integral garages, detached garages, etc. Any structural work within a residential structure including electrical, plumbing, mechanical, or new installation in a residential structure requires a permit as well.

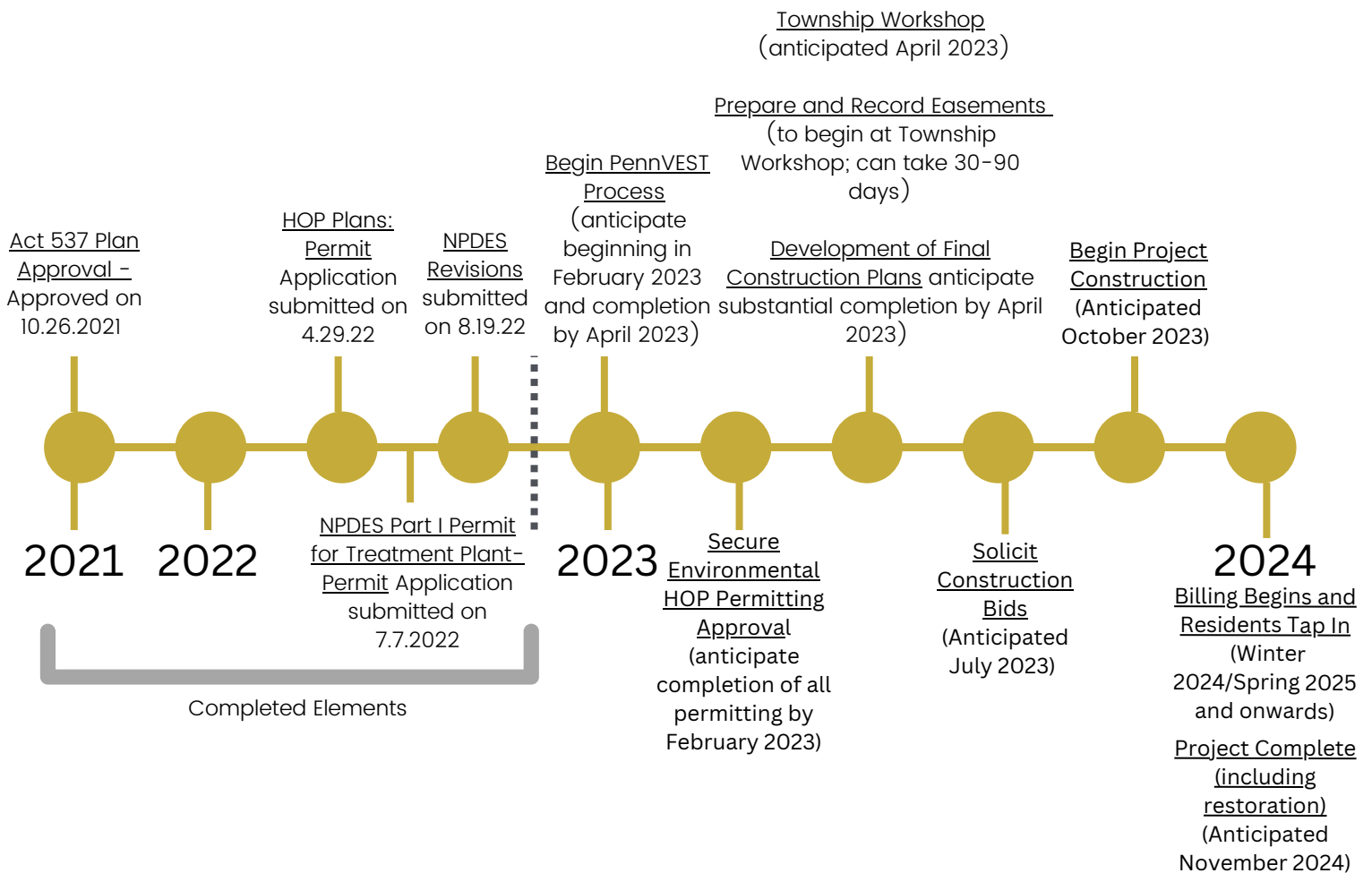
